Conditions on pharmacy premises - (The Medicines Act – Section 74D)

Summary:

Following the receipt of information, an inspection of the pharmacy and its services was conducted on 9 April 2026. The inspector found systemic weaknesses in the record keeping, risk management and governance of the pharmacy which presents a serious risk to patient safety. The risks identified are ongoing and are in relation to the prescribing service and supply of medicines liable to misuse to patients at a distance, without appropriate safeguards in place.

Conditions imposed:

1. The pharmacy must not sell or supply any pharmacy-only medicines via any distance selling service model, including through a website or by post/courier, except for fulfilling NHS prescriptions.
2. The pharmacy must not provide a prescribing service. This means that it must not issue any private prescriptions to any patients where these are provided or written by any prescriber employed by, working for, or on behalf of the pharmacy, or working at the pharmacy.
