Conditions on pharmacy premises - (The Medicines Act – Section 74D)

Summary:

An inspection was undertaken at the pharmacy on 18 March 2026, following information received by the GPhC. At the inspection, there were serious risks identified with respect to the prescribing, cryotherapy, and aesthetics service. There are system wide weaknesses with those private services and a lack of understanding of the appropriate governance structures that should be in place to ensure that care is provided safely and effectively. Record keeping for these services was inadequate, particularly given the nature of some of the medicines which were being prescribed.

Conditions imposed:

1. The pharmacy must not provide a prescribing service. This means that it must not issue any private prescriptions to any patients where these are written by any prescriber employed by, working for, or on behalf of the pharmacy, or working at the pharmacy.

2. The pharmacy must not provide a private (non-NHS) aesthetics service, including the prescribing, supplying or administering of any injectable medicines or medical devices except in pursuance of an NHS prescription or NHS commissioned service.

3. The pharmacy must not provide any private minor surgical procedures, including cryotherapy.

Outcome:

Conditions number 1 and 2 revoked with effect from 24th July 2026.

Condition number 3 ongoing
