



# Enforcement action summary (Conditions)

**Summary:**

A re-inspection of the pharmacy on 17 June 2025 found that the pharmacy had taken action towards remedying the systemic weaknesses in the governance of the pharmacy which had been identified in an inspection of the pharmacy on 22 October 2024. The risks identified were in relation to the provision of its private prescribing service. The nature of the failings were such that Conditions were imposed to protect the safety and wellbeing of the public.

The re-inspection also identified that although the Conditions were not imposed with the intention of restricting the pharmacy's aesthetics service, that service did involve the prescribing of botulinum toxins for administration in the course of providing the service, and therefore fell within the scope of the Conditions.

Varying the conditions to exclude the aesthetics service would enable the pharmacy to continue providing that service while still protecting the safety and wellbeing of the public.

**Conditions varied:**

1. The pharmacy must not provide a prescribing service, with the exception of the prescribing service in relation to its aesthetics service. This means that it must not issue any private

prescriptions to any patients where these are written by any prescriber employed by, working for or on behalf of the pharmacy, or working at the pharmacy (with the exception of prescriptions issued for items to be administered in the course of its aesthetics service)
